

Mr. and Mrs. Boyd testified that the owner is currently in a care facility and not inhabiting the home.

The hearing for the property at 644 Wertz Ave SW, Canton, Ohio was called to order by Dr. Stephen Hickman at 11:42 AM.


The property owners, Thomas and Heather McPherson, were not present. Gus Dria was sworn in to testify.


The property owner, Noel Wood, was not present. Gus Dria was sworn in to testify.






The owner was not present. Gus Dria was sworn in to testify.
