The hearing for the property at 722 Young Ave NE, Canton, Ohio was called to order by Dr. Stephen Hickman at 11:27 AM.


Property owner, Mary Coleman, was not present. Rick Miller was sworn in to testify.

Mr. Miller requested this to be declared a public health emergency and ordered it to be declared unfit for human occupancy and to be abated by December 10, 2017 and for Canton City Health Department to be authorized to abate the nuisance or to use appropriate legal action to secure compliance, if necessary. The cost of the abatement is to be placed on the taxes of the property as a lien, in accordance with law.

The hearing for the property at 1716 Rowland Ave NE, Canton, Ohio was called to order by Dr. Stephen Hickman at 11:32 AM.


Property owner, Todd R. Larson, was not present. Rick Miller was sworn in to testify.

There being no further testimony, the hearing ended at 11:33 AM.



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
Monday, November 27, 2017 Hearing
