
## Monday, December 15, 2021 Hearing


The hearing for the property at 2055 – 3<sup>rd</sup> St SE, Canton, Ohio was called to order by Dr. Stephen Hickman at 11:34 AM.

The property owners, Mark and Lori Crider, were not present. Gus Dria was sworn in to testify.

Mr. Dria declared that the property did not meet environmental standards (i.e. inoperable plumbing/no potable water service at an occupied property, the accumulation of rotting food, junk, clutter, trash, garbage, rubbish and debris, foul and noxious odors, poor cleanliness and general unsanitary conditions). Mr. Dria requested this to be declared a public health nuisance and ordered it to be abated and the house to remain vacant until passing satisfactory Building Department and Health Department inspections and for Canton City Public Health to be authorized to abate the nuisance or to use appropriate legal action to secure compliance. The cost of the abatement is to be placed on the taxes of the property as a lien, in accordance with law.

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
