COVID-19 Drive-Thru, Pop-Up Testing Site Available in Canton

Canton, Ohio – Canton City Public Health announced today a COVID-19 Drive-Thru Pop-Up Testing event will be held at the Stark County Fairgrounds this Wednesday, December 9 between the hours of 9:30 AM – 3:30 PM. This will be a drive-thru clinic only. There is no cost and the clinic is open to all with no appointment or health care provider referral needed.

“We are proud to be able to provide this service to the people of Canton and Stark County.” stated Jim Adams, Health Commission for Canton City Public Health. “An event of this kind is no small undertaking and could not happen without the support of numerous partners.
