# Ohio Seasonal Influenza and Influenza-like Illness Surveillance 2009-2010 Season, beginning August 30, 2009

MMWR Week 47 November 22-28, 2009

## Media Talking Points

#### Activity Level: Widespread Activity

• Definition: Increased ILI in at least half of the regions AND recent (within the past 3 weeks) lab confirmed influenza in the state.

**Summary**: Public health surveillance data sources indicate continued elevated levels of confirmed influenza-associated hospitalizations and influenza-like illness from sentinel providers not typical for this time of year, although these levels are decreasing. The percentage of emergency department visits with patients exhibiting constitutional symptoms has decreased for the fifth consecutive week.

#### Surveillance Data:

- Influenza-like Illness (ILI) Sentinel Providers reported 1.86% of patients had ILI signs and symptoms. Influenza-like Illness is defined as a fever (≥ 100° F), **and** cough <u>and/or</u> sore throat. Temperature can be measured in the physician's office or at home.
- Over-the-counter (OTC) sales experienced a statistically significant deviation from the expected in four regions.
- Emergency department visits experienced a statistically significant deviation from the expected in six regions.
- ODH lab reported results for those cases that are PCR positive for seasonal influenza. Positive results: (1) influenza A/H1, (1) influenza A/H3 (total through 11/30/09).
- Results obtained from pandemic influenza A H1N1 testing conducted at the ODH laboratory are now included in the chart below (total through 11/30/09).
- Seven confirmed influenza-associated pediatric mortality reports have been reported in the 2009-2010 season: one from Athens County, three from Cuyahoga County, two from Franklin County, and one from Warren County. Three of these mortalities had confirmed pandemic (H1N1) 2009 infection (through 12/1/09).
- Incidence of confirmed influenza-associated hospitalizations in 2009-2010 season: 2860, of which 1317 are laboratory confirmed as Pandemic (H1N1) 2009 Influenza (as of 11/30/09).
- Incidence of year-to-date confirmed influenza-associated hospitalizations: 3579, of which 1417 are laboratory confirmed as Pandemic (H1N1) 2009 Influenza. See Pandemic (H1N1) 2009-related hospitalizations graph (as of 12/2/09).
- Year-to-date confirmed Pandemic (H1N1) 2009 Influenza-related deaths among hospitalized patients: 40
- Cumulative influenza and pneumonia (P & I) deaths reported via the Electronic Death Registration System (EDRS): 1565, of which 103 are presumed to be influenza.

#### National Surveillance Data:

- During week 46 (November 15-21, 2009), influenza activity continued to decrease in the U.S.
- Nationwide during week 46, 4.3% of patient visits reported through the U.S. Outpatient
  Influenza-like Illness Surveillance Network (ILINet) were due to influenza-like illness (ILI). This
  percentage is above the national baseline of 2.3%. All 10 regions reported ILI above regionspecific baseline levels.
- During week 46, 8.2% of all deaths reported through the 122-Cities Mortality Reporting System were due to pneumonia and influenza (P & I). This percentage was above the epidemic threshold of 7.0% for week 46. Including week 46, P & I mortality has been above threshold for eight consecutive weeks.

### **Analysis Considerations:**

• Influenza-associated hospitalization became a reportable condition on 1/1/09. Therefore, only cases that were entered after 1/1/09 will be considered for analysis purposes.
