
# Stark County's Influenza Weekly Report Week 47 (11/17/2019 – 11/23/2019)



#### **During Week 47:**

- Stark County had 0 influenza-associated hospitalizations.
- Nationally, 1 influenza-associated pediatric death was reported.
- During Week 47, the following specimens were collected nationally from public health laboratories:

# So Far this Year:

- There have been 2 influenza-associated hospitalizations in Stark County since 9/29/2019. Two additional cases were reported before Week 40 2019.
  - > Age range and median age is not available due to low case count
- The national cumulative rate of influenza-associated hospitalizations was 2.0 per 100,000.
- Nationally, five influenza-associated pediatric deaths were reported so far this year
- Up to Week 47, the following specimens were collected nationally from public health laboratories:




# Stark County Age Adjusted & Cumulative Rate of Influenza-Associated Hospitalizations per 100,000.



# **Graph 1:** Hospitalized and Non-Hospitalized Influenza Cases Reported to the Local Health Department.


◆ There was 1 case of hospitalized or non-hospitalized influenza reported for Week 47 in Stark County. Last year at the same time there was 1 case reported. Stark County increased to 6 cases reported so far this year compared to 8 at this time last year.





#### Graph 2: Sentinel Provider Reported Influenza Like Illness (ILI) in Stark County.


During Week 47, Stark


◆ ED and Stat Care visits for respiratory and constitutional syndrome decreased to 31.47% of ED visits, and remained above the multi-year baseline average during Week 47.

◆ ED and Stat Care visits for ILI + Fever for MMWR Week 47 decreased to 3.27% of ED visits, but remained above the multi-year average.



 48 schools reported.




# Map: Weekly Geographic Influenza Activity Estimates Reported by State and Territorial Epidemiologists Syndromes.
