There being no further testimony, the hearing ended at 11:19 AM.

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

The hearing for the property at 903 5th St NE, Canton, Ohio was called to order by Dr. Stephen Hickman at 11:19 AM.


The property owners, Roger Matz, was not present. Gus Dria was sworn in to testify.



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
