Resolution 2020-13

A resolution by the Board of Health of the Canton City Health District Adjusting Pay Compensation for Board of Health Employees.

WHEREAS, the Board of Health desires to fairly compensate all employees for their work; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canton has authorized non-bargaining unit employees to receive up to a 2% increase in wages and salary at the discretion of their appointing authorities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health desires to make these compensation adjustments to account for a costof-living adjustment; and

WHEREAS, the wage and salary schedule for the Canton City Board of Health has not been adjusted since 2015.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED

- 1) All employees are eligible for a wage and salary increase of 2% based on their rate of pay as of December 31, 2020 with the following exceptions:
 - a) Employees in their probationary period as a new hire will not receive a pay increase until the end of their probationary period. At the end of their probationary period they will receive the scheduled increase approved by the Board at the time of hire.
- 2) Increase the minimum rate of pay for each classification by 2% and the maximum rate of pay for each classification by 5%, as shown in Attachment A Board of Health Wage and Salary Schedule, January 1, 2021.
- 3) The Health Commissioner is authorized to correct any ministerial or de-minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or the numerical total sums of this resolution during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Any changes will be reported to the Board of Health.
- 4) That this resolution is necessary for the general operation of the health district and that it becomes effective January 1, 2021.

COVID-19

There are a few brief updates on COVID-19 that I will provide in this report.

- We continue our contact tracing and monitoring efforts. We have prioritized contacting new cases of COVID-19 by phone pursuant to the Ohio Department of Health guidance. Not all cases get a phone call, but all cases reported to Canton City Public Health receive a letter from our department detailing information that they can use to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the community as well as information detailing their suggested isolation period.
- Our contact monitoring efforts (monitoring those under quarantine for an exposure to a COVID-19 case) are extremely busy. Those that are placed in an active monitoring status are contacted once every two or three days during their monitoring period. Alternatively, those that choose to do so may submit their monitoring information daily via text message.
- We have developed an on-line request form for individuals to request documentation of their isolation or monitoring periods as we typically do not send a letter releasing an individual from isolation or quarantine.
- We are shifting resources towards COVID-19 vaccination planning. We have been told that public health could begin receiving shipments of vaccine as early as December 22, 2020. We are developing plans for vaccination of EMS and other groups identified by the Ohio Department of Health to receive these first doses of vaccine. (Tier 1-A). Depending on the availability of vaccine, this effort could begin on December 28, 2020. Vaccination efforts will continue to ramp up over the next few weeks as supplies become more available. It is impossible to provide a definite timeline for this effort.
- We have conducted two drive-through testing events. The first, on December 8, 2020, tested 667 individuals. Of those 136 were positive for COVID-19. Of the 136 positive tests, 33 were Canton City Residents. We are hosting another testing event on December 16, 2020. The details of this event were not available for this written report and will be provided at your meeting.

Racism as a Public Health Crisis

The previously reported grant proposal to the Stark Community Foundation was not funded. We did receive two donations from other directed funds, The Herbert and Janet Fisher Philanthropic Fund and The Helen McInnes Advised Charitable Fund, totaling \$3,000 for this effort. We thank them for their support. The work on this project is important. Due to the rapid pace of COVID-19 planning and vaccination efforts, work on this project will be delayed into the new year.

Public Health Ethical Practices

A written report on the provision of Shringrix vaccine to eligible employees was provided to the Board at the November meeting. After discussion, it was recommended that this committee reexamine this issue with expanded membership to include representation from outside the department as well as other suggestions. Due to the rapid pace of COVID-19 planning and vaccination efforts, work on this committee will be delayed into the new year. The department will not offer any new vaccinations to staff until the issue is reviewed and a policy is approved by the Board.
