The hearing for the properties at 1237 15th St NW, Canton, Ohio was called to order by Dr. Stephen Hickman at 11:45 AM.


Property owner, Terri L. Pribula, was not present. Gus Dria was sworn in to testify.

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The hearing for the property at 328 Grandview Ave NW, Canton, Ohio was called to order by Dr. Stephen Hickman at 11:47 AM.






The owner was not present. Gus Dria was sworn in to testify.

There being no further testimony, the hearing ended at 11:51 AM.



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


The owner was not present. Gus Dria was sworn in to testify.
