Who qualifies to receive the flu shot at Canton City Public Health?

1. Children 6 months through 18 years of age
2. Adults 19 years and older who do not have any insurance coverage for the influenza vaccine.*

*All adults with insurance for vaccinations (such as those with AmeriHealth Caritas, Anthem, Buckeye, CareSource, Cigna, Humana, Medicaid, Medicare, Molina, Paramount, United Healthcare Community Plan, or any private insurance) are encouraged to get vaccinated at their primary care physician's office, a local pharmacy, or other agencies providing flu vaccinations.

We appreciate you adhering to the qualifications listed above.

Adults and children that qualify can receive vaccination by **scheduling an appointment** during our regularly scheduled clinics times as follows:

Monday 8:00am - 11:00am and 1:00pm - 3:00pm
2nd Thursday of every month 4:00pm - 6:20pm
