

Canton City Health Department Mission Statement

The Board of Health of the Canton City Health District, operating through the divisions of the Canton City Health Department, desires to control communicable disease and to protect the health and well being of those people living, visiting, and/or working within the jurisdictional area of the Canton City Health Department.

Under authority of the Ohio Revised Code and the rules and regulations of the Canton City Health Code, the Canton City Health Department is to provide public health service to all people without regard to race, creed, color, handicap, age, sex or political orientation. Public health responsibilities of the Canton City Health Department shall include, but not be limited to, the following activities:

1. Abate and remove all nuisances within its jurisdiction.
2. Receive reports of dangerous infectious diseases, consolidate such reports and forward to the Ohio Department of Health.
3. Enforce such procedures as are required to control disease.
4. Receive birth and death records, forward reports to the Ohio Department of health, issue certified copies and analyze reports.
5. Enforce the Administrative Code regarding environmental health regulations including, but not limited to, food service operations, school inspections, rabies control, air pollution control and swimming pools.
6. Provide public health laboratory services necessary to support other operating divisions of the Canton City Health Department.
7. Uniformly and impartially enforce all chapters of the Canton City Health Code.
8. Provide public health education to individuals or groups interested in promoting, maintaining and improving the good health and full potential development of people living within the jurisdictional area of the Canton City Health Department.

For infants through school-age children. Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Walk-in basis.

➤ **WIC (Women, Infants & Children) Program**

Supplemental food and nutrition education for low-income pregnant and breast-feeding women, infants and children to age 5. By appointment only. Please call (330) 489-3326.

➤ **Help Me Grow™ Program**

Public Health Nurses visit first-time and teen mothers and their babies to provide parenting information, health education and assistance with connecting to community resources.



➤ **Lead Testing Clinic**

For children age 1 to 5. Walk-in basis.

1st and 3rd Monday of the month, 8:00–10:30 a.m.

➤ **Tuberculin Skin Testing**

Walk-in basis.

➤ **BCMh (Bureau for Children with Medical Handicaps)**

Assist children and families with special health care needs.
