- "Breathe for Change: Mind > Body > Wellness" (virtual)

Mind, Body, Wellness presentation included breathing techniques, a "power pose" and some ice-breaking exercises that can be used in any setting. Rebecca discussed a theoretical approach to mindfulness, along with three (3) interconnected layers of wellbeing. She also led a group exercise in identifying an accountability buddy to better insure attaining one's stated goal. We believe these skills are transferrable to PREP staff and will aid in youth engagement during PREP cohorts.
