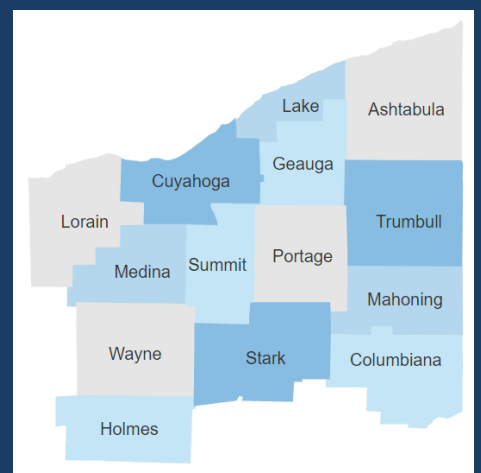

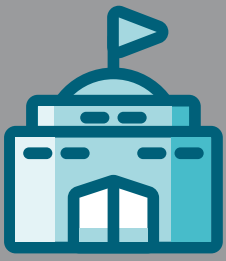

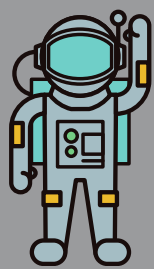


Want to check out college life?

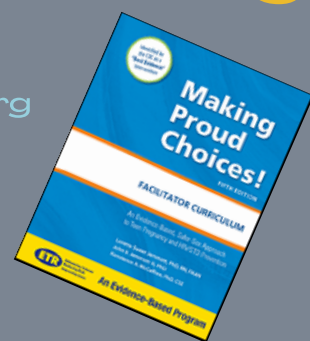
