Rabies Vaccination Clinic to be held Saturday, May 5

Stark County residents can take advantage of low-cost rabies vaccinations for their dogs, cats and ferrets by attending the Spring Rabies Vaccination Clinic, this Saturday, May 5, 2018. The clinic will be held at the Stark County Fairgrounds in the Wildlife Building from 1:00 – 3:00 p.m.. Cost is \$10.00 per pet, cash only.

Pets must be leashed or in a carrying cage, at least 3 months old and in good health. First time shots will protect an animal for one year. Thereafter, a vaccination against rabies protects for three years.

The vaccinations will be administered by veterinarians, assisted by Public Health Department and Dog Warden staff and volunteers. All dogs, cats and ferrets in Stark County are required to be vaccinated against rabies.

Stark County dog licenses will also be available for purchase at this event.

Please protect your pets and yourselves from rabies. Have your pets vaccinated. This event is sponsored by the Stark County Rabies Advisory Council. Call the Canton City Health Department with questions at (330) 489-3327.
