Air Quality Advisory Issued

James M. Adams, Canton City Health Commissioner, has issued an Air Quality Advisory for Stark County due to high levels of Ozone. With the National Weather Service forecasting mostly sunny skies and high temperatures for the remainder of the week, ozone concentrations may remain at a level that is unhealthy for sensitive groups. People with respiratory disease, children, older adults, and people who are active outdoors should consider limiting prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.

You can help reduce levels of ground-level ozone by driving less and refueling your vehicle after sunset.
