

WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WHO HAS COVID-19

Have you:
Received a COVID-19 vaccine booster?
OR
Completed your primary vaccine series of Pfizer **less than** 5 months ago
OR
Completed your primary vaccine series of Moderna **less than** 6 months ago?
OR
Received one dose of Johnson & Johnson **less than** 2 months ago?
OR
Had a positive COVID-19 test and fully recovered in the last 90 days **before** exposure?



No



- Stay home for 5 days after your last exposure, then wear a well-fitting mask when you are around others for the next 5 days
- Get tested on day 5, if possible
- If you develop symptoms, stay home and get tested
- If you are unable to wear a well-fitting mask, stay home for 10 days.

Yes



- Wear a well-fitting mask when around others for 10 days after last exposure
- Test on day 5, if possible
- If you develop symptoms, stay home and get tested
- If you are unable to wear a well-fitting mask, stay home for 10 days.
